Please be advised that it is the Board's practice and intent to conduct a thorough investigation of the allegations presented. The Board's staff is processing your complaint at this time and will, subsequently, present it to the Board for review and authorization of any necessary action. The Board will correspond with you as soon as a determination is made in this matter.

While the Board recognizes your interest in resolving your complaint, the Board staff is not permitted to provide updates as to the status of complaints. Please be aware that the Board's Adopted Rules, N.J.A.C. 5:35-1.2, state:

Any complaints, statements, information, or documents obtained or prepared by the Board staff or the Board are deemed confidential and not subject to public disclosure during the course of the preliminary investigation or investigation to determine whether a violation of the Local Government Ethics Law has occurred, except as necessary for the Board's staff or the Board to conduct the preliminary investigation or investigation.
